Terms and conditions

Poster competition

“girls worldwide say no to violence against women”

Who can participate?

All WAGGGS members, individuals as well as groups and troops can participate at the competition. Please submit only one entry per person or group. The contact person for the submission needs to be over 18 years old (for example a Brownie leader can submit on behalf of her Brownies).

What should be submitted?

Poster designs have to include the slogan “girls worldwide say no to violence against women”. The message and design needs to support the ‘say no to violence against women’ campaign. The choice of method and material is up to you.

When should it be submitted?

The competition starts on 8 March 2010, International Women’s Day and ends on 12 August 2010, International Youth Day. Winners will be announced in September.

Which information is required for the submission?

- A copy/scan/photo of the poster
- The location where the poster is displayed, the time period it is displayed and how many people are likely to see the poster*
- Any additional action that has been taken to support the ‘say no to violence against women’ campaign
- Who was involved in the production of the poster
- Name, postal address where packages can be received, email address and phone number of a contact person aged 18 years or older.

Where should you send the submission?

You can email it to waggggs@wagggsworld.org, send it by post to WAGGGS World Bureau, 12c Lyndhurst Road, London NW3 5PQ England or fax it to +44 207 431 3764. By submitting your poster, you give WAGGGS the rights to use it for non-commercial purposes, like promotion and advocacy.

The submissions will be judged by a panel of WAGGGS staff and volunteers taking into account the poster design as well as the potential impact of the poster due to the place where it is displayed. The winners will be notified by email and announced on the WAGGGS website.

What is the prize?

Everybody who helped to raise awareness to end violence against women is a winner! The posters of the three winners will be on display at the Unifem headquarters in New York and they will also be published online on the say no campaign page and for one day, on the Unifem homepage. The winners will receive a goodie bag with Unifem gift items and a certificate.
